

**Robert M. Russell, MD**

Robert M. Russell, MD, is Professor Emeritus of Medicine and Nutrition at Tufts University. Russell has served on many national and international advisory boards including the USDA Human Investigation Committee (Chairman), the FDA, US Pharmacopoeia Convention, National Institutes of Health, the World Health Organization, UNICEF, and the American Board of Internal Medicine. He has worked on international nutrition programs in several countries including Vietnam, Iran, Iraq, Guatemala, China, and the Philippines. Dr. Russell is a member of numerous professional societies, on the editorial boards of five professional journals, a past president of the American Society for Clinical Nutrition, and a former member of the Board of Directors of the American College of Nutrition. He will be President of the American Society for Nutrition for 2010. Dr. Russell co-edited the last two editions of *Present Knowledge in Nutrition* and was the Editor in Chief of *Nutrition Reviews*. He is staff physician-emeritus at the Tufts Medical Center in Boston and served as a member of the IOM's Panels on Folate, Other B Vitamins, and Choline, and as chair of the Panel on Micronutrients. He is former chair of the Food and Nutrition Board, and a fellow of ASN. Dr. Russell presently serves as a specialist-advisor to the National Institutes of Health.
